### **NEW READING BOOKS FOR SCHOOL**

During Term 2, Mr Maitland and Mrs Corrie spent lots of time researching a new reading scheme for our school with our current stock of books becoming depleted and also out of print. They looked at lots of different schemes and decided upon Oxford Reading Tree for P1-P3/4 and Collins Big Cat Readers for P4-P7.

Oxford Reading Tree will be familiar to many of our parents with Biff, Chip, Kipper and Floppy still around not having aged in 30 years! The Collins scheme was chosen for the large numbers of high-interest and factual books that are sure to keep our KS2 pupils entertained whilst developing their reading skills.

The new schemes represent a big investment for us at a time when finances are a struggle for all schools. We have invested over £6000 in these new reading resources for our pupils, but we couldn't do this without the incredible support of our parents!

A final massive thank you to Mrs Marshall who spent every day for 2 weeks before the Easter break labelling and organising every single one of our new books into a user-friendly shelving system.
